ABOUT US | ANEI MĀTOU

The Kaipara Moana Remediation Programme is the largest landscape programme of its scale underway in New Zealand.

It represents new models of co-governance, planning, collaborating and problem-solving to restore the health and mauri of the Kaipara Moana.

The vision was set by the parties who signed a Memorandum of Understanding - Ministry for the Environment, Northland Regional Council, Auckland Council, Ngā Maunga Whakahī o Kaipara, Te Uri o Hau and Te Runanga o Ngāti Whātua.

Our mahi is guided by Four Pou. Each of the the Pou individually represent challenges and opportunities, while together the Pou represent KMR's journey towards achieving success. The project is about working together, collaborating and looking at the harbour as a whole. It's the start of a generational change.

FOUNDATION PLANTING

We're looking for land that's ready for planting.

If you've got fenced areas close to a waterway in the Kaipara Catchment, we'd love to hear from you.

Here's the criteria:

- You have a minimum of 20ha of land (or can join with neighbours to get a minimum of 20ha) AND
- fenced wetland areas, riparian areas, or other fenced areas near waterways ready to spray and plant AND
- have a minimum of 1ha of land to plant, or,
- have a community planting restoration project (wetland or riparian).

HOW IT WORKS | HEI ARATAKI

You meet the criteria on the left, and are ready to plant this winter (Winter 2022)

You email your details to planting22@kmr.org.nz saying you're interested in taking part in foundation planting this.

Our team will be in touch, to sort out a visit from one of our trained field advisors who will arrange a time to visit, and talk you through the planting plan and the wider Sediment Reduction Plan process.

Once we've signed off the planting plan, our team will liaise with a KMR Accredited Nursery to arrange supply and delivery of plants to your site.

Then it's time to get planting! Your advisor will follow up within 6 months.

- If you're planting more than 1500 plants, you'll need to get a contractor in for spraying and planting. We have an accredited list of contractors who we work with.
