

Kaipara Moana Remediation – Schedule of Prices 2021-2022 (May 2022)

The following table provides the Schedule of Prices for the set price arrangement that the KMR Programme has adopted as of May 2022. A set price has been adopted which the KMR Programme will pay for the corresponding service. In line with the KMRs joint funding arrangement, the KMR will contribute **up to 50%** of this cost, with the remainder being provided by the recipient of services. These prices are inclusive of contract oversight, set out and earthworks. These prices are provided to inform contractors who are seeking to become KMR Accredited and are subject to change, including but not limited to a price review occurring each year to keep up with changing market conditions. **Note: all prices are exclusive of GST.**

Freight - Delivery of plants to property

Where freight is used, there is a maximum of 2 x 120km round trips per planting season. Any further costs incurred a will be liable to the landowner.

Fencing

Difficulty of fencing is decided by KMR field advisor in conjunction with the landowner. Difficulty assessed on accessibility, terrain and complexity of fencing (eg. qty of turns in fence)

Fencing & Gates

Troughs are only funded for areas where a KMR project excludes animals from a drinking water source (Speak to a KMR field advisor for clarification) KMR can fund up to \$600 per trough with a maximum of 5 troughs if deemed necessary.

The intention of funding **gates** is to ensure if animals do manage to get in to the planted area, the landowner can safely remove the animal(s). KMR can fund up to \$175 per gate, with a maximum of 5 gates if deemed necessary.



Note: At this time KMR is not paying for the use of battens, if they are required it is at the cost of the landowner.
